

The **B60** with coin mechanism - **the original café babyfoot table**

The B60 is the original model found in most French cafés, hotels and restaurants since the 1960s.

The cabinet, which features a coin mechanism, is made of premium solid and laminated beechwood. The carpentry joints are reinforced with steel elements so they can stand up to anything. The game's mechanical and moving parts are made from hi-tech materials for better play.

The cabinet opens for access to the coin mechanism, pitch and ball return. The opening is secured with a lock.

Glass-topped B60

This model is a B60 fitted with a safety-glass top and a railing to prevent ball theft. It is designed for public spaces (game rooms, hotels, etc.) and high-traffic areas (train stations, shopping centres, etc.) that require special measures to prevent ball theft. The split base opens to provide access to the coin box and an internal storage space.

Premium solid beechwood, 100% premium beech laminated wood, polyurethane varnish

Opens for access to the coin box and for pitch cleaning

Rods

Interchangeable telescopic rods made of ground steel with a hard chrome finish
